This will offer delegates the amazing sensation of playing as part of an orchestra...even though they may never previously have placed so much as a penny whistle to their lips!

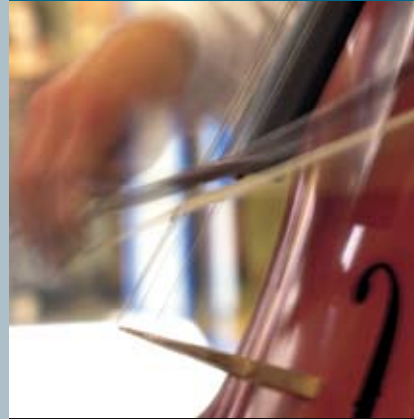

This fascinating project calls for hard work and intense concentration from all involved. Participants will be stretched to their full potential and be able to see beyond their perceived limitations.

Most importantly, they will never forget that electrifying moment when the raised baton brings them to animated life as a symphony orchestra.
